On The Move Seminar II - visas 13-20 March 2017 - Recife, Brazil

Dear friends,

We are pleased to invite your organisation to our second global seminar of the On the Move project, focusing on the topic of visas.

In a small group of 15 people, we will:

- **Reflect and educate** - think about why young people are crossing borders, discuss the realities of visas from a structural approach and with an anti-capitalist critique, and analyse the current visa codes and EU directive
- **Discuss and share** - our stories and experiences with visas, analyse the results of the IFM-SEI visa survey and meet with embassies to share our views and demands on visa regulations
- **Planning and supporting others** - share ideas and create a plan for an IFM-SEI visa website for members of IFM-SEI and wider, from setting objectives to developing content together

Profile of participants

We invite one person per organisation to work on this topic with us in Recife who:

- Has some experience on the topic or is very interested in the topic and able to do research prior to the seminar
- Has experience in your organisation, for example as a group leader or volunteer
- Is able to follow up on the meeting in your organisation (e.g. by supporting the development and/or maintenance of the visa website)
- Is aged between 18 and 30
- Is able to communicate in English or Spanish

Overall, we aim to have gender balance in the group, therefore we may ask for you to select a different participant if needed.

Each participating organisation must pay the participation fee for the On The Move project, as agreed at the beginning of the project, at either this seminar or the third seminar in June. The amount is 500€ per European organisation and 250€ per non-European organisation.

Travel arrangements: You must arrange your participant's travel and send the travel confirmation to contact@ifm-sei.org by Sunday 15 January 2017, 23:59 (CET). Participants can arrive up to 2 days before the meeting starts and stay up to two days longer, provided they pay for their own accommodation and expenses.

Visa arrangements: You will find a visa guidance letter from Mirim Brasil accompanied to this invitation, which you should read carefully. After the application deadline you will then receive visa invitation letters from both IFM-SEI and Mirim (if applicable).

Travel insurance: Please take care of your own travel insurance and note that these costs cannot be reimbursed by IFM-SEI. You may also have to visit a travel clinic in advance of travelling to Brazil to check you are up to date with any necessary vaccinations.
