

WHAT DO THE EMBASSIES WANT TO KNOW?

Find out with official visa forms what embassies want to know from you, when you are going to visiting these countries.

MATERIALS

- Visa forms
- Flipcharts
- Writing materials
- PCs and internet(depends on step 1)

OBJECTIVES

- Take a look at real examples of visa forms
- Discuss the information asked there and its relevance

PREPARATION

Look for visa forms (depends on what you want to do in step 1)

STEP-BY-STEP

1. Print out visa forms from countries all over the world. It is also possible that the participants search them on their own, like where to find a visa form.
2. Then they should try to fill the visa form.
3. Write on a flipchart paper what are the main things asked in the different forms. Look also at what is the most common information they ask.

DEBRIEFING

- If searched, was it easy to find the form? Can everyone look for them? (access to internet)
- Did anyone look at where you have to present this form? Is easy to get there for everyone?
- What do you think governments want all this information from you for? Why?
- Do you think they should be asking for all of this?
- Is easy to fill these forms and is it possible for all people to fill these application forms? Think about the language and the words used.

TIPS

You can do a lottery to choose the country each participant or team is looking the visa form from or which visa form you are giving them.
