## Resolution on Stopping the Bombing of Yemen

The civil war in Yemen is known as one of the biggest humanitarian crisis in the world. This situation is unacceptable! Since 2015, two million children have had to quit school. 2500 schools are out of service, and one-third of these schools have been destroyed during the war. The food situation is catastrophic. Only 57 percent of Yemen's import-needs were covered last year, and the UN estimates that 22 million people need humanitarian aid, including 1.8 million undernourished children. Less than half of the hospitals and health clinics are operational, which means that over 15 million Yemenis are without access to health care.

Throughout the eastern part of Yemen, cholera, a life-threatening diarrhea, has spread rapidly and only 45 percent of the population has access to clean water. In addition to all this, three million people are internally displaced, refugees in their own country. The UN agency OCHA calls the situation in Yemen the largest humanitarian crisis in the world.

This conference resolves that all countries and the United Nations must work to stop the war in Yemen as soon as possible.
