Resolution on the Development of the IFM-SEI Migration Network

This Congress highlights the importance of the Migration Network structure to work effectively and to reach the network's goals in line with the IFM-SEI values. The Migration Network must focus on an exchange of the member organisations to find best-practice examples and shape a common way of how we can be inclusive. The network should be open to all interested members and the coordinator(s) should be elected in line with the IFM-SEI Constitution.

This Congress notes that the Migration Network needs a programme for the next period 2019-2022. The Congress highlights that the Migration Network should concentrate on establishing a working group together with socialist migrant- or refugee-led organisations. This working group should be working on two tasks:

- 1) Make the organisation more inclusive for refugees and migrants; reflecting on organisational structures.
- 2) Establishing national/regional cooperation between IFM-SEI member organisations and refugee and/or migrant led organisations.

This Congress highlights the importance of cooperating with other groups. IFM-SEI can only face the problems of marginalised displaced young people by giving them a chance to participate in our structures.
