The International Falcon Movement - Socialist Educational International (IFM-SEI) is looking for participants for the **Capacity Building and Creative Toolkit Development Activity**.

The event will take place in Ljubljana, Slovenia, between 21 and 28 November 2021 and will be hosted by the Slovenian Falcons Union. The activity is part of the “Dream our G->Local Movement” workplan supported by the European Youth Foundation of the Council of Europe.

Do you want to learn more about creating accessible, inclusive, and engaging approaches to planning and delivering educational activities around volunteering on local, national and international level?

Then apply to join our training, where you will:

- Learn about social inclusion and diversity in volunteering projects.
- Develop competencies to create creative educational resources.
- Cooperate with other passionate young people on the creation of a toolkit on accessible and inclusive campaign development that will reach and influence IFM-SEI members around the world.

Apply if you are:

- 16-30 years old,
- active in IFM-SEI member organisation, youth movement or grassroots organisation,
- passionate about social inclusion and diversity,
- motivated to contribute to the development of toolkit on inclusive volunteering,
- confident in working in English (*Spanish and French interpretation will be provided if necessary*).

What is Dream Our G->Local Movement?

The main aim of the project **Dream our G->LOCAL Movement** is to reflect on our own practices regarding accessibility and inclusion and find ways to improve our movement. Together with other organisations working with underserved youth and children, we will

support a young generation of youth workers to develop accessible and inclusive approaches to engage in youth work locally, nationally and internationally.

More specifically, the main objectives of the project are:

1. Identify the ways in which youth work is inaccessible and exclusionary to marginalised youth on local, national and international levels by identifying whose voices are not represented and the reason that it is difficult to engage and retain volunteers from marginalised and underserved communities.
2. Strengthen collaborations and partnerships between youth organisations to share good practices across the sector and promote inclusive and sustainable youth engagement.
3. Deliver a training to young people that builds an understanding of the relevance of local activism in addressing global issues and enable youth to facilitate global to local activities.
4. Support young people in implementing a g-local campaign to widen their organisational reach to engage underserved youth.
5. Deliver a capacity building workshop to develop and publish a creative toolkit on accessible and inclusive g-local volunteering.

Arrival: 21 November 2021

Departure: 28 November 2021

The **participation fee** is 50 EUR. It covers food and accommodation for the entire activity as well as required materials during the event.

Travel expenses will be reimbursed partly up to 70%. They will be reimbursed when a signed “Reimbursement form” as well as all the original tickets are submitted to the Secretariat and participants provide all needed justificatory documents of travel and expenses (invoices, boarding passes, train or bus tickets...).

IFM-SEI welcomes applications from all young people irrespective of gender, disability, marital or parental status, ethnic or social origin, colour, religion, belief or sexual orientation. We specifically encourage young people with fewer opportunities to apply.

We do not want costs to be a participation barrier. If you need support in paying your travel costs or participation fee, please contact the IFM-SEI secretariat.





Corona Safety Measures: Check all the travel requirements for entering and returning from Slovenia so you are aware of the measures of the country and have all the necessary travel documents. If you need a negative test for your return journey, please get in contact with the Secretariat, so we can arrange a testing before your departure.

During the event the participants will have to wear surgical or FFP2 masks. Before the event we will also send you a sanitary protocol that will have to be respected during the activity.
