

E-mpACT: “Advocacy and Capacity Building” training course in Lima, Peru Call for Trainers

Are you an expert in facilitating engaging youth training and are passionate about empowering young people to become successful advocates in e-learning and youth work?

IFM-SEI is looking for expert trainers for a 5-day international activity, **27 July - 2 August 2024**, as part of the E-mpACT project. As a trainer, you will have the exciting opportunity to travel to Lima, Peru and broaden the knowledge and expertise of 14 young people on advocacy, e-learning and developing policy papers. You will be guiding sessions about advocating towards national and EU decision-makers for inclusive youth work and e-learning on Covid-19 impact and international solidarity policies.

Who are we?

The International Falcon Movement - Socialist Education International (IFM-SEI) is an international educational movement working to empower children and young people to take an active role in society and fight for their rights. We are an umbrella organisation for child and youth-led movements all over the world, educating on the basis of our values of equality, democracy, peace, co-operation, solidarity and friendship. Through our member organisations and our international activities, we aim to ensure that children and young people are well informed about their rights and are empowered to ensure they are respected.

What is “E-MPACT”?

“E-mpACT is a three-year project addressing the needs of youth during and after the Covid-19 pandemic through digitalisation, e-learning and non-formal education.

Covid-19 severely impacted young people during the pandemic, especially those from marginalised communities. Everything moved online and with limited access to digital youth work, millions were pushed even further away. In the blink of an eye, non-formal activities and youth workplaces that provided a social safety net for young people disappeared.

E-mpACT is a response to this and uses e-learning and digitalisation as a tool to empower youth organisations and raise awareness on the pandemic's impact on non-formal education and youth work. The project will analyse social impact and youth worker's perceptions of the challenges of digital literacy, to advocate for accessible youth work in relation to the pandemic and solidarity policy with neighbouring countries of the EU and different regions in the world.

Advocacy and Capacity building training is the next phase of E-mpact. This event will train 14 participants aged 18-30 from 7 countries in what is advocacy and different advocacy methods, using non-formal education methodology. Los Cachorros, our Peruvian partner, are hosting the event and will organise the day-to-day logistics. The knowledge and skills developed in the training will be applied to creating an EU policy paper using the results of the E-mpACT project. There will be 2 trainers, 2 IFM-SEI staff and Los Cachorros team supporting the event and participants.

The main **objectives** of this activity are:

1. Broaden participants knowledge and expertise on how to use e-learning and digitalisation to improve and/or increase youth work
2. Educate and empower the participants on how to be successful advocates in local, national and global contexts, and teach different methods of impactful advocacy
3. Develop an EU policy paper on inclusive digitalisation after the impact of covid-19 in youth organisations

What will be your responsibilities as a trainer?

- Design and implement non-formal education sessions for a 5-day training
- Create exciting, positive team dynamics for group work
- Educate and explain different components of advocacy, campaigning, policy paper development and e-learning in fun, engaging and informative sessions
- Create strong cohesion in an international group of young people

Who can apply?

- Non-formal education trainer
- Proficiency working in English
- Good understanding, knowledge, and previous experience in advocacy and/or policy paper development



- Preferably experience designing and implementing e-learning activities

The training will take place from 27th July to 2nd August 2024, Lima, Peru (including travel days)

*****The trainer will be paid for the services provided. The fee we offer is for the entire involvement (online preparation with the team, the week-long training, short evaluation after the training and reporting).***
