Working Together for Peace

Utøya, Norway
24-30th March 2025

Are you an expert in developing engaging human rights trainings? Are you passionate about empowering young people to become peace advocates?

IFM-SEI is looking for experienced trainers to lead an international workshop on the three level of peace. As a trainer, you will have the opportunity to broaden the knowledge and expertise of youth workers to work on Peace education and its three levels: relational, global and inner peace. The activity will be a 5 days' workshop conducted through non-formal education, with 50 participants coming from different places of Europe.

WHO WE ARE?

The International Falcon Movement - Socialist Education International (IFM-SEI) is an international educational movement working to empower children and young people to take an active role in society and fight for their rights. We are an umbrella organisation for child and youth-led movements all over the world, educating based on our values of equality, democracy, peace, cooperation, solidarity and friendship.

Through our member organisations and our international activities, we aim to ensure that children and young people are well informed about their rights and are empowered to ensure they are respected.

WHAT IS “Working Together for Peace”?

Working together for peace is a project for 50 youth workers coming from different organisations in Europe that will take place in Utøya, Norway, from 24-30 March 2025.

The aim of the activity is to enable youth workers to acquire and build knowledge and skills to better manage conflict. The project seeks to build their capacity to work for peace within their organisations and in the world, and to provide them with educational tools to develop seminars and workshops about the three levels of peace.

The purpose of the project is to work on peace on three different levels: relational, in the world and inner peace. The workshop will be implemented with non-formal education and will explore peace on multiple levels, combining mental health workshops, interpersonal communication strategies, and discussions about the state of the world and ongoing conflicts.

We acknowledge that finding the tools to work for peace is challenging for youth workers who are stressed and overwhelmed. That is why, we will create the space to work on inner peace - and facilitate a safe arena to explore how to better take care of one's mental health during times of stress.

During the workshop, participants will:

1. Identify the importance of peace education to build sustainable, just, and supportive societies.
2. Explore the barriers that voluntary organisations face in promoting these values and to propose mechanisms to help them in their mission.
3. Analyse realities inside and outside Europe, share experiences and reflect on the causes and consequences of conflict.
4. Highlight the importance and raise awareness of self-care and inner peace
5. Gain the skills and knowledge to be peace advocates and conduct workshops on the topic.
6. Create tangible and lasting resources to ensure sustainability of the project and access to materials by other youth workers interested in peace education.

The training will take place from **24th to 30th March 2025**, Utøya, Norway (including travel days).
