


WAR DOES NOT AFFECT EVERYONE IN THE SAME WAY

The LGBTQI+ refugees are confronted with challenges such as restricted access to accommodation, employment and social integration, a lack of access to specific healthcare for transgender and intersex people, and no recognition for same-sex partnerships, limiting family reunification

WHAT IS THE SITUATION OF UKRAINIAN REFUGEES SINCE 2022?

Millions of Ukrainians have crossed the borders and many are displaced within Ukraine

It is necessary to address the specific needs and realities of each vulnerable group, such as LGBTQI+ refugees

There are more than 3.8 million Ukrainian LGBTQI+ refugees who have fled the country.




IN UKRAINE, THERE ARE NO LEGALLY RECOGNISED LGBTQI + CIVIL UNIONS

This means that

- If an LGBTQI+ soldier is wounded in combat, their partner cannot visit them in hospital.
- Visiting rights are limited to legal family members, and LGBTQI+ partners are not recognised as such.


